Then for thirteen years, 1995 through 2008, Sue worked for the Iowa Waste Reduction Center, providing environmental technical assistance to all types of small businesses. Sue has also been instrumental in developing the High Voltage Vehicle certification for safe management of electric and hybrid vehicles, and the Recall Certification for airbag safety and sales in an online audit system for tracking compliance with the standards.
